ECBA™ certification

In order to obtain this certification, you will have to register for the exam on the IIBA website, pay the exam fees and pass the exam.

CCBA™ certification

To earn the CCBA™ certification, candidates must complete a minimum of 3'750 hours of business analysis work experience in the last 7 years, among which a minimum of 900 hours on each of the 6 BABOK® Guide Knowledge Areas or a minimum of 500 hours in each of 4 of the 6 BABOK® Guide Knowledge Areas, complete a minimum of 21 hours of Professional Development within the last 4 years, provide references and agree to Code of Conduct and Terms and Conditions. You will then have one year to enroll and pass the associated exam.

CBAP™ certification

To earn the CBAP™ certification, candidates must complete a minimum of 7'500 hours of business analysis work experience in the last 10 years, among which a minimum of 900 hours in 4 of the 6 BABOK® Guide Knowledge Areas for a total of at least 3'600 of the required 7'500 total, complete a minimum of 35 hours of Professional development in the last 4 years, provide two references, agree to Code of Conduct and agree to Terms and Conditions. You will then have one year to enroll and pass the associated exam.
