In this course, you will learn all the steps from importing raw material to the finished clip. This includes material management, rough and fine editing, image and sound post-processing with transitions, titles and effects as well as formats.

  - Volume adjustment and sound mixing
  - o Apply Essential Sound control panel and audio effects

  - Overview of different video formats and properties
  - Media export settings for different video formats
  - Exporting for Facebook, YouTube, Vimeo, and other social media channels
  - Using export presets
