Methodology & didactics



Two to four weeks before the course the participants receive the official book and further preparation materials. The seminar requires at least 20 hours of additional time outside the classroom.

The course consists of a three-day interactive course consisting of presentation and group exercises, followed by the exam in the afternoon of the last day of the course. Please keep the evenings free for repetitions and/or smaller homework. The preparation and processing of the homework will contribute significantly to the success of the exam.

It will help those familiar with traditional IT and service management concepts to confidently discuss «digital», develop practical skills and integrate new concepts, techniques and technologies into their way of working. Certification
