## Certification

The exam voucher is included in the course costs.

The exam can be done at Digicomp or at home/office (with online proctor). The exam preparation time is between 8-12 hours.

#### Exam schedule:

**Level 1 Exam:** The exam is in closed-book format, and includes 40 multiple-choice questions. The pass score is 60% (24 out of 40 questions). The exam lasts for 60 minutes and can be taken at PearsonVUE test centers.

**Level 2 Exam:** The exam is in open-book format, and includes 8 complex multiple-choice, scenariobased questions. The pass score is 60% (5 out of 8 questions). The exam lasts for 90 minutes and can be taken at PearsonVUE test centers.

Level 1 and 2 Combination Exam: This exam consists of two separate sections. The TOGAF® 10 Foundation Level 1 exam is closed-book. The TOGAF® 10 Certified Level 2 exam, Section 2 is openbook. (Note: At Prometric testing centers, an electronic copy of the specification is built into the test and is only available in Part 2). Time limit: 150 minutes total. Each section has a maximum time limit as follows: 60 minutes on TOGAF® 10 Foundation Level 1 and 90 minutes on TOGAF® 10 Certified Level 2. Once you have completed the TOGAF® 10 Foundation Level 1 section, you cannot go back.
